We are all in this together. We will ensure residents have trusted sources of information and will co-ordinate and promote local community support. Not everyone has access to the internet so we really want to know who you are and how we can provide information for you. Please let us know so we can help.

Stick to the facts: Avoid misinformation on social media and consider taking breaks from endless conjecture on coronavirus. We should all use the comprehensive official advice from the government, NHS, Dept. of Health & Social Care, and Public Health England (PHE) and check that advice regularly.

Stay at home, protect the NHS, save lives: We must only leave home for four reasons: 1) shopping for basic necessities, for example food and medicine, *which must be as infrequent as possible;* 2) one form of exercise a day, for example a run, walk, or cycle - alone or with members of your household; 3) any medical need, including to donate blood, avoid or escape risk of injury or harm, or to provide care or to help a vulnerable person; 4) travelling for work purposes, but only where you cannot work from home.

Volunteer to deliver food and medicine: Swale Borough Council is asking for volunteers now to help with deliveries of food and medicines to those identified by government as vulnerable and most in need. You must not be in one of the government's high-risk categories. Training is given and social distancing strictly followed. Volunteer by going to their website <u>swale.gov.uk/community-response</u>
