Clockhouse Lane, Boughton Under Blean

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 TEMPORARY ORDER OCTOBER 2020

To allow renewal works to be carried out on the level crossing, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Clockhouse Lane, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 18th October 2020 for up to 1 day between the hours of 07:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (KL870FDM-53-51-181020SM - Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage on site and the works will be displayed on one.network


Clockhouse Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the level crossing, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while renewal works are undertaken by Network Rail Infrastructure Ltd.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Clockhouse Lane, Selling Road, Brenley Lane and vice versa.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the closure.
