**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)
THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
TEMPORARY ORDER AUGUST 2026**

Openreach works.

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Perry Wood & Stonestile Lane, Selling.

Closures are planned from 4th August 2026 with estimated completion by 5th August 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 17:00, or where stated on valid Permits (BC411001WGRFDH7K & BC411001WGRKR96W - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Perry Wood will be closed approximately 40m north of Stanley Cottages, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Stonestile Lane will be closed approximately 330m south of the junction with Selling Road, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

Only one road will be closed at any one time.

The closures are required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Beeches Road, Stonestile Lane, Selling Road, Perry Wood and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
