Openreach works.

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Perry Wood, Selling.

A closure is planned from 26th February 2026 with estimated completion by 27th February 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGMFRP3F-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Perry Wood will be closed south of the junction with Grove Road, heading approximately 100m in a southerly direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Grove Road, Shepherds Hill, Perry Wood and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
