TEMPORARY ORDER FEBRUARY 2026**

**Openreach works.**

**To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Perry Wood, Selling.**

**A closure is planned from 26th February 2026 with estimated completion by 27th February 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGMFRP3F-02 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)**

**Perry Wood will be closed south of the junction with Grove Road, heading approximately 100m in a southerly direction, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.**

**The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.**

**The alternative route for any through traffic is via Grove Road, Shepherds Hill, Perry Wood and vice versa.**

**Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.**
