**Openreach works.**

To allow pole and cabling works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Fox Lane, Boughton Under Blean.

A closure is planned from 25th March 2026 with estimated completion by 26th March 2026, between the hours of 08:00 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (BC411001WGFMF526J-01 - Openreach). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on [One.Network](#)

Fox Lane will be closed in the vicinity of Overlands Farm, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while pole and cabling works are undertaken by Openreach.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via South Street, Hickmans Green, Colonels Lane, The Street, Stockers Hill, Canterbury Road, A2 Boughton Bypass, Brenley Roundabout, London Road, Canterbury Road, Selling Road, Fox Lane and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
