## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

## **TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2025**

Southern Water works.

To allow defect works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Hogbens Hill, Selling.

A closure is planned from 14th May 2025, with estimated completion by 15th May 2025, between the hours of 09:30 and 18:00, or where stated on a valid Permit (LQ003SWAT13492700-04 - Southern Water). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on <u>One.Network</u>

Hogbens Hill will be closed in the vicinity of Peacock Place, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while defect works are undertaken by Southern Water.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Selling Road, A2 Canterbury Road, A251 Ashford Road, Newhouse Lane, Winding Hill and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
