## Summary of main issues

- 1. Area of wasteland at the station is unsightly.
- 2. Funding is available for regeneration.
- 3. Residents have made suggestions.

# Location and size of area – see plan

- Site is approximately 5.5m x 25m, with a wall bordering the south side.
- The south section (5.5m x 7m) is mostly clear of vegetation while the north section (4.5m x 18m) is significantly overgrown and contains 3 large trees and one smaller tree.

#### Concerns

- Structural safety of wall responsibility of SER.
- ASB unlikely as site overlooked and relatively busy.
- Liability/insurance site to remain under ownership of SER.

## **Funding**

- SER is offering £1500 labour and materials but must be used by April.
- Other funding streams are available, eg SER Community Improvement Fund (£1000-£50,000).

# **Proposal**

- Approach the project in stages, to be completed as and when funding and timing allow.
- Phase 1 south section (in order of priority, funded by grant from SER):
  - o Remove fence on car park side and make good fence on platform side
  - (Install fence to divide from north section depending on wishes of SER)
  - Clear rubbish and weeds and make good all surfacing
  - Make good internal aspect of wall (could include rendering and painting?)
  - o Install planters as per plan suggest recycled plastic (provided by Axis?)
  - Install benches as per plan suggest recycled plastic (provided by Axis?)
  - Install boards on internal aspect of wall
  - Community involvement to (fill and) maintain planters suggest each is 'adopted' by a local group
  - o Community involvement to populate boards suggest old photos, school artwork, etc
- Phase 2 north section (funded by further grants):
  - Clear rubbish and weeds, leaving existing trees
  - Install community garden suggest compost heap, bug boxes, planting, paths, benches, etc
  - Community involvement to maintain
  - Would need to liaise with owner of neighbouring property
